Helen Roy will be conducting a one day training session presenting new Anishinaabemowin strategies to teach young children. Participants will gain knowledge and understanding of how you incorporate the language into existing curriculum and will also learn new ways to teach children the basics of Anishinaabemowin.

This training is designed to familiarize teachers with methods using the cognitive approach, increasingly favored by experts in language acquisition. The emphasis will be on conversations applicable to everyday subjects, immersion techniques, and other techniques intended to simulate the environment in which most people acquire their native language as children. The hands-on approach to learning with regards to the full meanings of the sounds of the language will be explained.
