Scholarships will be awarded to Elementary, Secondary, and Post-Secondary First Nation Students:

- 2 - University
- 2 - College
- 3 - Secondary 1st, 2nd, 3rd
- 3 - Elementary 1st, 2nd, 3rd

Criteria:

- Must be presently enrolled in a language course;
- Must be enrolled as a full time student;
- Good attendance;
- Involvement in community and/or extra curricular activities;
- Recommended by an Education Counselor, Teacher, Elder, Principal and or Vice-Principal;
- Dedicated to maintain the continuum of the Anishinaabe Language.

Application forms must be accompanied along with:

1. Recorded cassette tape / Cd /mp3 containing a 3-5 minute speech on why you feel the Anishinaabe Language is important and ways of learning the language effectively. **Speech must be in the Anishinaabe Language;**
2. **Post-Secondary applicants** must **submit** their **fall 2009 semester grades** as well as their mid-term for February if available which should include a Language course completed or in progress;
3. **Elementary and Secondary applicants** must **submit** their **first term grades** which should include a Language course completed or in progress;
4. **Letter of recommendation** from the Education Counselor, Teacher, Elder, Principal and or Vice Principal;
5. Copies of **awards, certificates, diplomas** or other supporting documents which highlight your achievements.

DEADLINE DATE: FEBRUARY 12, 2010

Late applications will not be considered.

Selection Procedure:

All applications will be screened and reviewed by the Scholarship Review Committee.

Presentation of Awards:

The recipients for all scholarships will be notified by February 26, 2010. Each scholarship recipient will be invited to attend the Anishinaabemowin Teg Language Conference Banquet to be held at Kewadin Casino in Sault Ste. Marie, Michigan.
